**Purpose and Programme**

The seminar is aimed to expand the technical understanding of Engineer and Planner practitioners by describing the trip generation research, databases, transportation assessments and integrated policy work being undertaken in New Zealand, United States, United Kingdom and Australia.

A more detailed programme and the list of presenters will be forwarded to registrants. Prior to the seminar participants will be provided with abstracts of the main presentations and also a list of propositions and questions circulated for discussion on the day.

**Seminar Route Map.**

1. In the first morning sessions there will be an overview of current trip generation research in New Zealand including a description of some significant surveys, recent major research reports and a presentation on best NZ practice for Integrated Transportation Assessments. (9.00-10.45am)
2. Before lunch and in the two post lunch sessions the equivalent international experience will be described including practitioner support and best practices, with examples from America, England and Australia.
3. At Lunch the *TDB 2009 AGM* will provide light relief, staged debate and time for 'shop talk' (12.00 to 1.30pm)
4. For the last quarter, after some workshop group discussion on matters raised during the day, the attendees will come together to participate in a lively peer panel debate covering some key questions. (3.45-4.45pm)
